Lisa was a physical education teacher and head volleyball coach at Ralston Valley High School from 2000-2013. She lost her life on March 3rd, 2013 after a two-year battle with cancer. She was forty-three. Lisa touched many lives during her battle and during her thirteen-year tenure as a teacher and coach.

To commemorate her life and to ensure that she will continue to touch the lives of kids, the "Lisa Nelson Memorial Scholarship" was established. This year a Ralston Valley High School male and female **student-athlete** will be awarded a \$2500 college scholarship in memory of her.
